 - a. Don't be fooled by intentional misuse of economic concepts
 - b. Understand the world
- 2. Does it have to be boring?
 - a. No. Affects the world in very exciting ways.
 - b. Irrelevant question since it's so important.
- 3. What is macroeconomics?
 - a. Economy as a whole
 - b. No individuals, rather things like national input / output
 - c. Microeconomics investigates individual markets, individuals, etc
 - d. More "obviously relevant" than microeconomics understand the concepts in the news, etc.
- 4. Is this course hard?
 - a. Yes. Cover a *lot* of material.
 - b. No. Not very complicated material.
 - c. Very limited use of "mathematical puzzle solving"
