- I. Mysticism
 - a. B. McGinn: "A process of transformation affected by a desire for and a consciousness of the immediate presence of God.
 - b. Anchoress (femaile anchorite)
 - i. Eg: Julian of Norwich
 - ii. Last Rites administered, and Anchoress is walled up in a room to spend the rest of their life there.
 - c. Via Positiva → God is Knowable
 - d. Via Negativa → God is Unknowable
 - e. Mysticism = Heterodox (many theologies). Not specific to any one faith. Heresy?
- II. Julian of Norwich
 - a. Jesus as Mother
 - b. Bleeding Christ
- III. Margorie Kempe
 - a. Mother
 - b. Weepings Constantly. Disruptive.
 - c. Disrupting mass.
- IV. Gender interpretation
 - Women = More fluid. In touch with body. Hence Julian and Margorie with Blood, Jesus, etc.
 - b. Men = In touch with the MIND.
- V. Everyman
 - a. Allegory. Duh
 - b. Passion Play → Passion of Christ.
 - c. Morality Play → Any time, any "moral" event.
